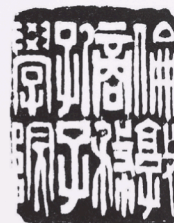

The programme delivers an intensive learning schedule: 20 lessons per week, 45minutes each lesson, 5 days per week.

In order to accurately assess the Chinese language proficiency of new students, ICLCC arranges a placement exam at the beginning of programme. Students will then be assigned to

appropriate classes in accordance with their proficiency from the exam.

ICLCC also offers elective courses, which include Chinese calligraphy, Chinese painting, Chinese songs, Tai Chi and Chinese martial arts, etc.

Tuition fee

Once accepted onto the programme, an offer letter and a tuition fee invoice will be sent to applicants. An official offer letter from Tsinghua University (for VISA purpose) will be sent to applicants once the full tuition fee is paid.

Change of application and refund policy

If you wish to withdraw from the programme the following refund policy will be applied.

Travel and accommodation

Students are responsible for making arrangements for their own travel, visas and accommodation. A visa is required to enter China so please contact your local Chinese Embassy for further details.

Students can also choose the accommodation provided by Tsinghua University. To guarantee booking, the accommodation fee must be received no later than **Friday 6 May 2011**. Bookings will be only accepted after this date if rooms are still available.
